Exit a rear door of the worship space, take a left, and the restrooms are on the right near the end of hall.

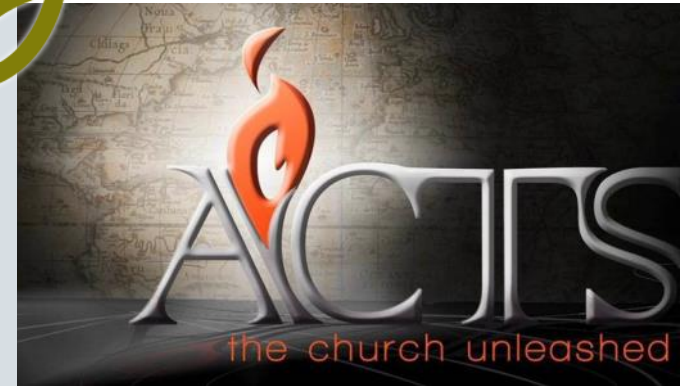
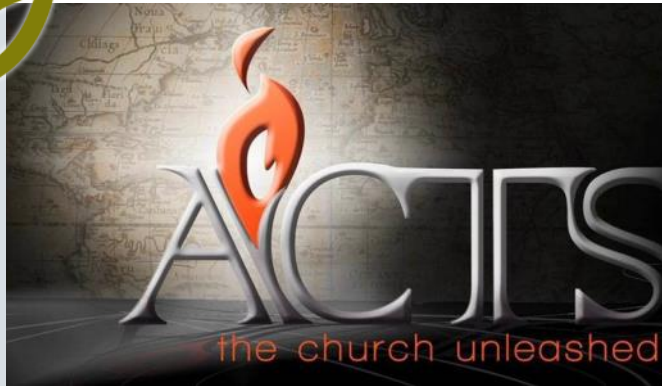
