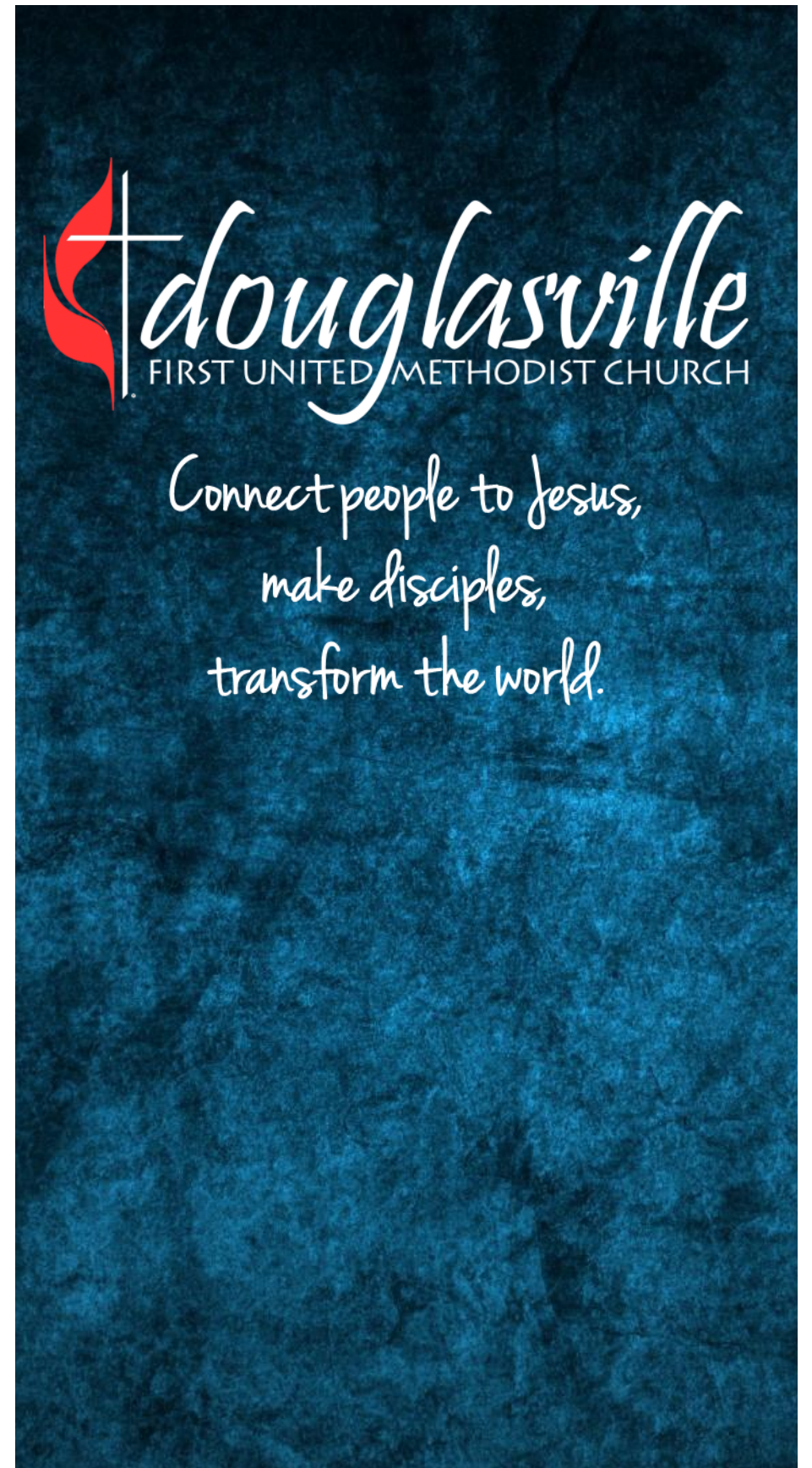
### AN INVITATION TO FOLLOW JESUS

Free us for joyful obedience, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.**

**People: In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven! Glory to God. Amen.**

### February is Black History Month

We celebrate the African-Americans who have played vital roles in the development of The United Methodist Church. Susan Angeline Collins was the daughter of Isaac Collins, an emancipated slave who also served in the Civil War. Susan worked for a pastor as a young woman and in 1887, at the age of 36, she was recruited as a missionary. She would go on to become the first American missionary bishop of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Africa and founded a school for girls in Angola in the early 1900's.
